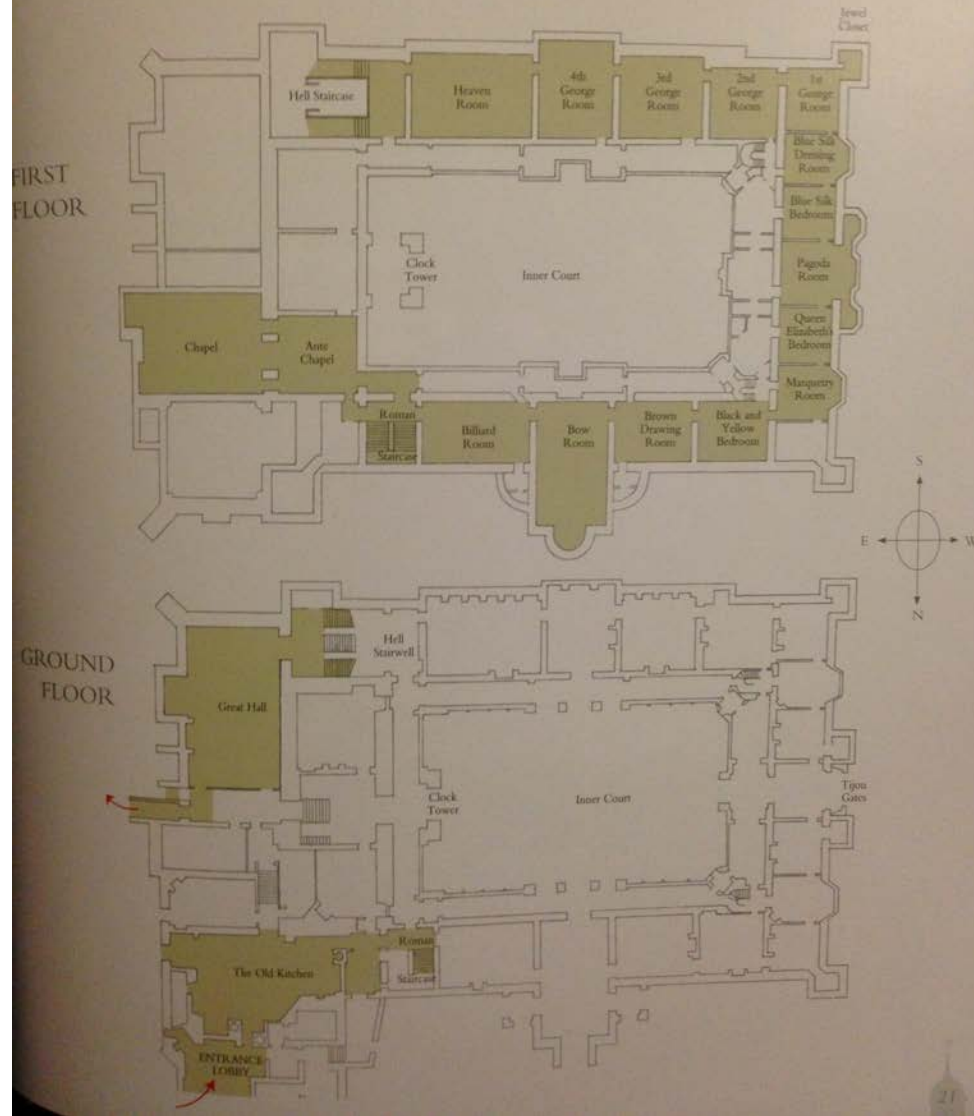

The tour of the House extends for over 250 metres throughout the ground and first floors, and passes through eighteen rooms, upon the walls of which are nearly 400 paintings.



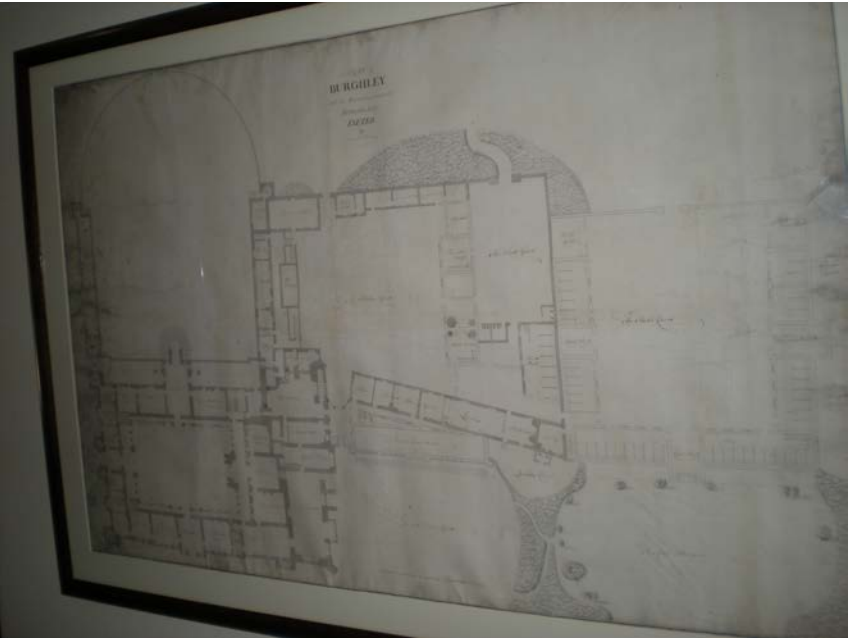
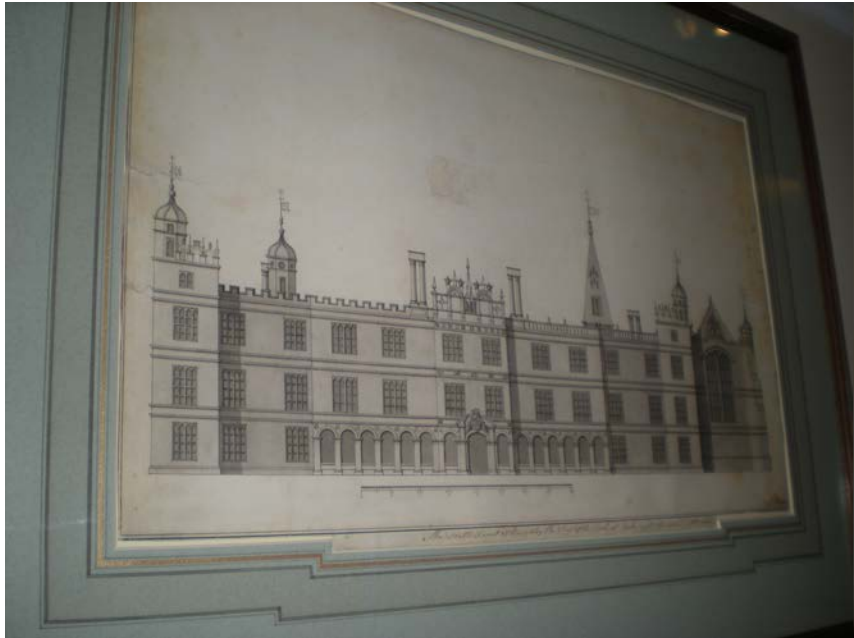








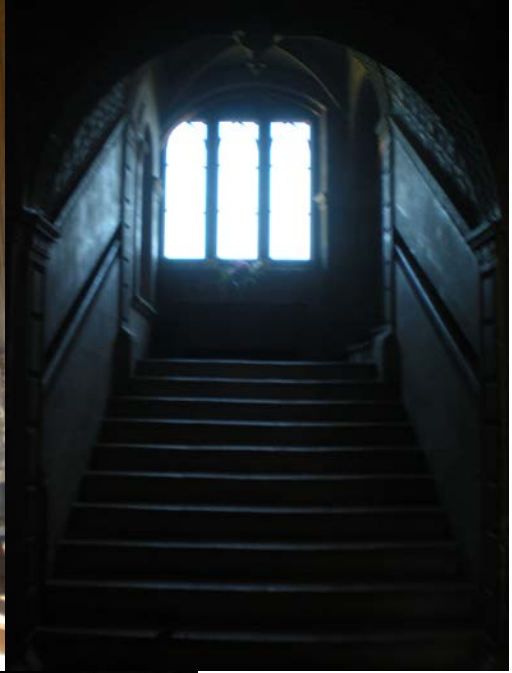


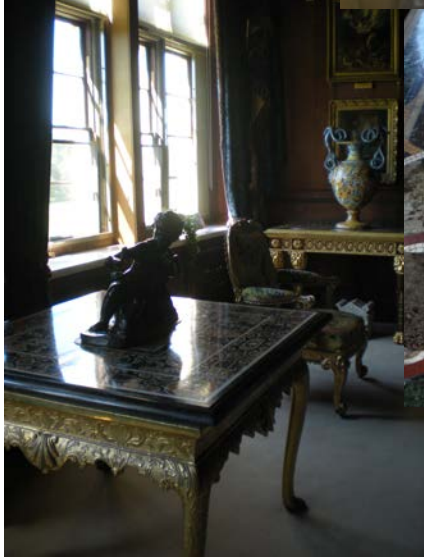


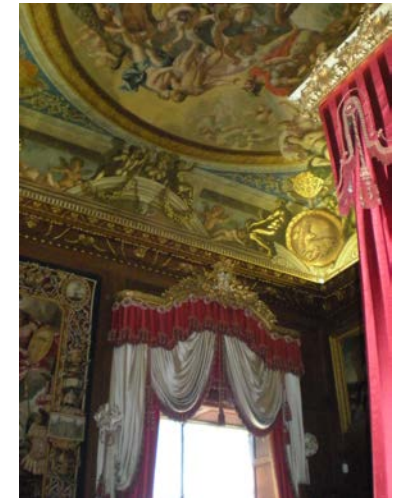
