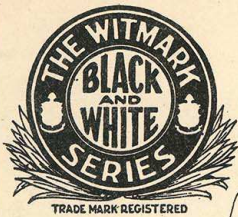

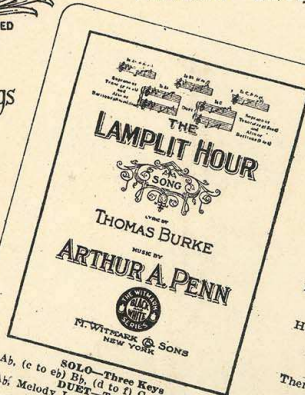

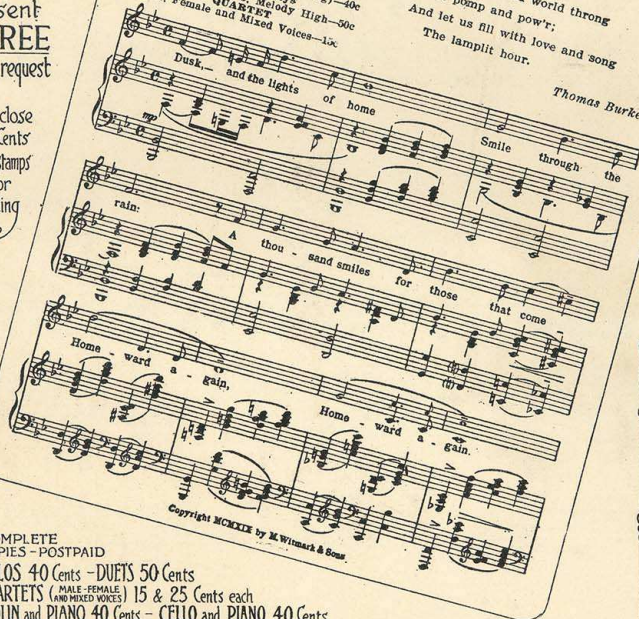
DUSK—and the lights of home

Here is our throne.

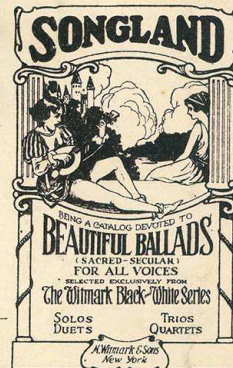
Then let the wild world throng
